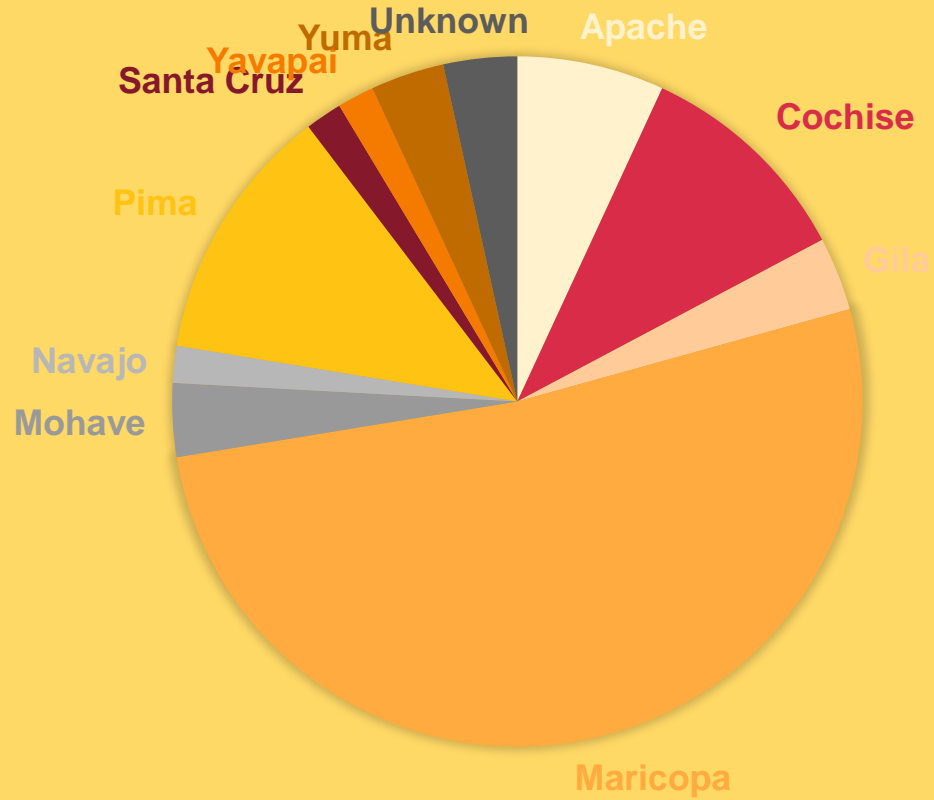

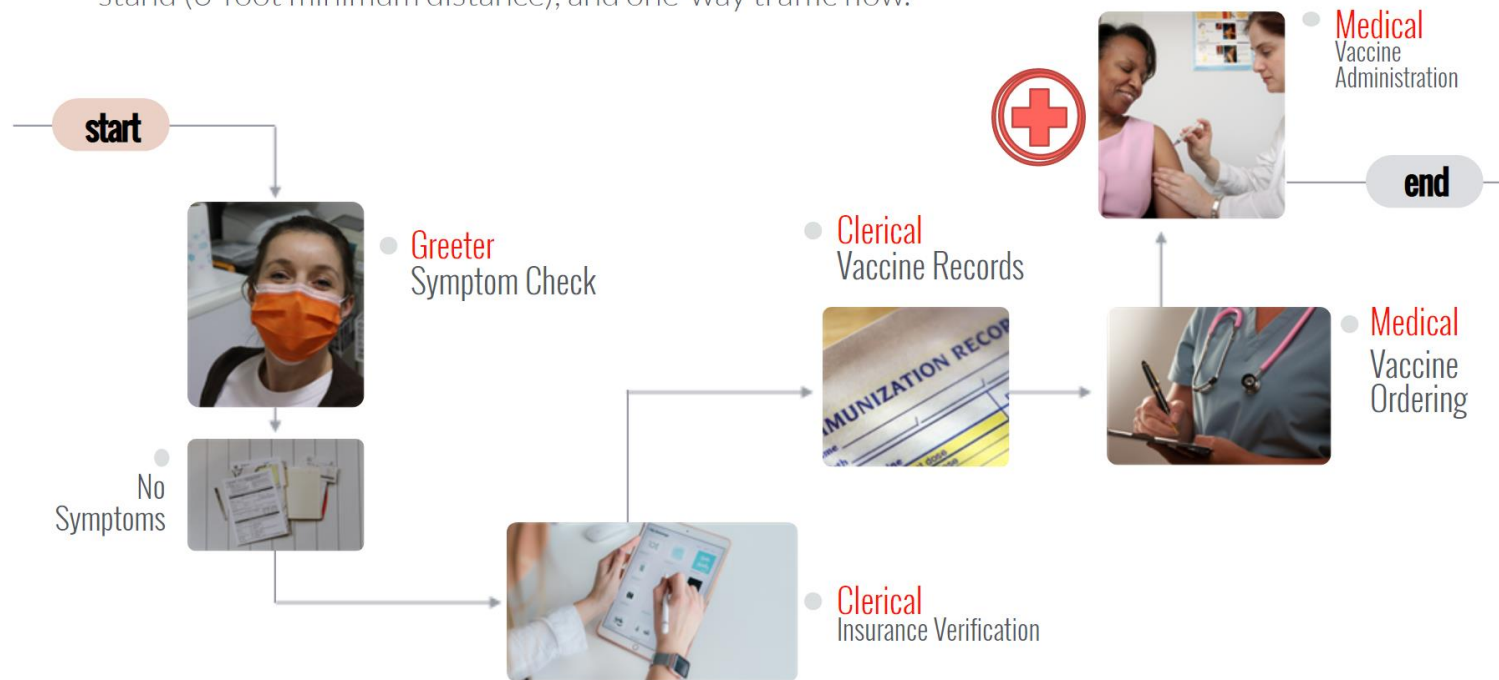

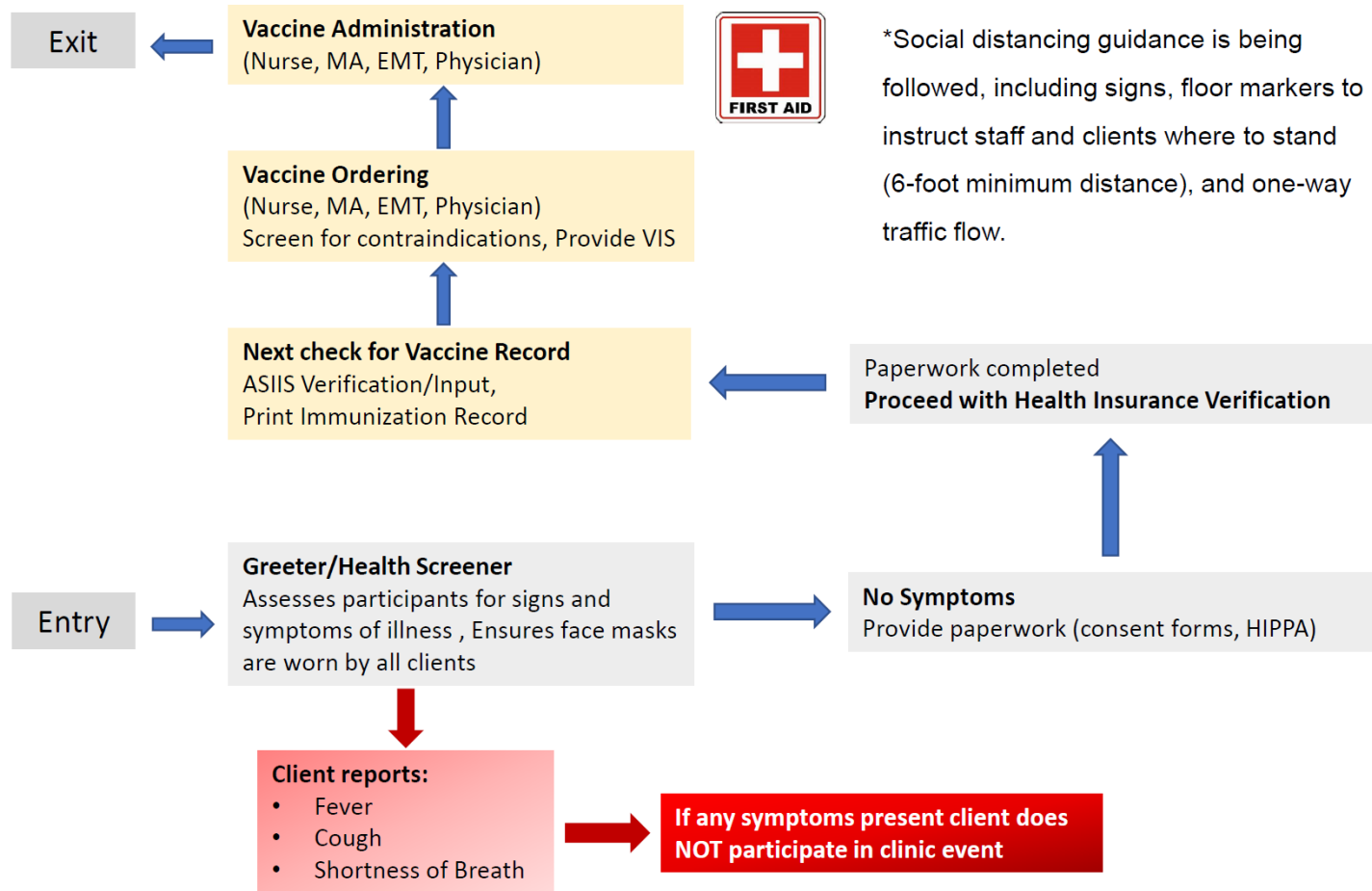

CLINIC FLOWCHART

Ensure social distancing guidance is being followed, including signs, floor markers to instruct staff and patients where to stand (6-foot minimum distance), and one-way traffic flow.



Sample Clinic Flowchart

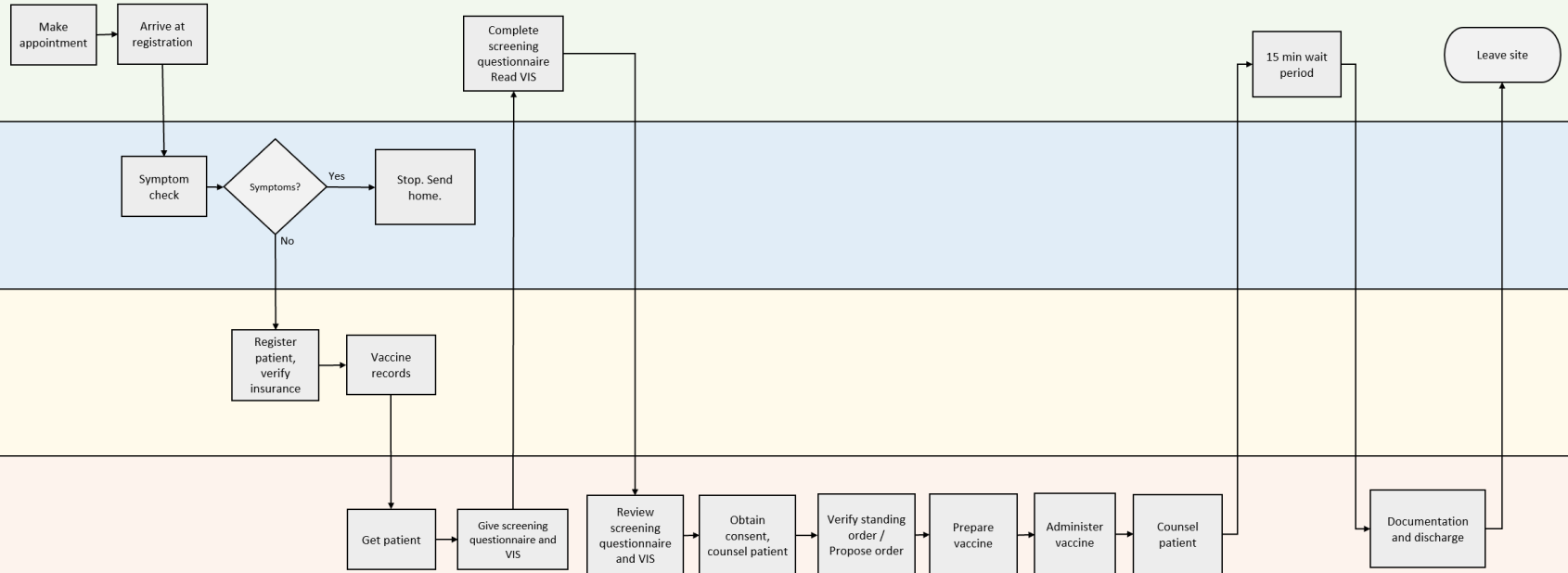

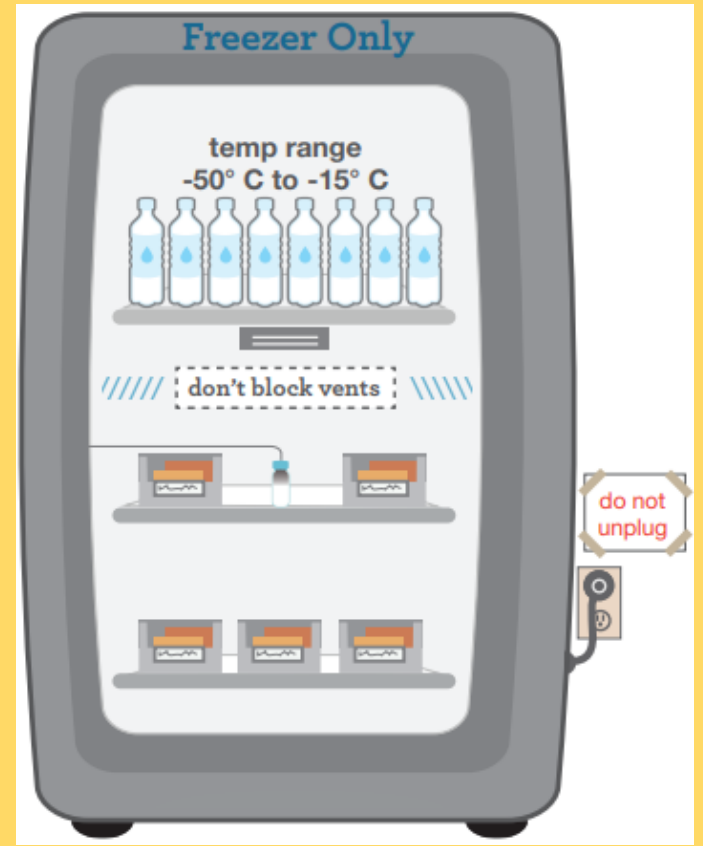
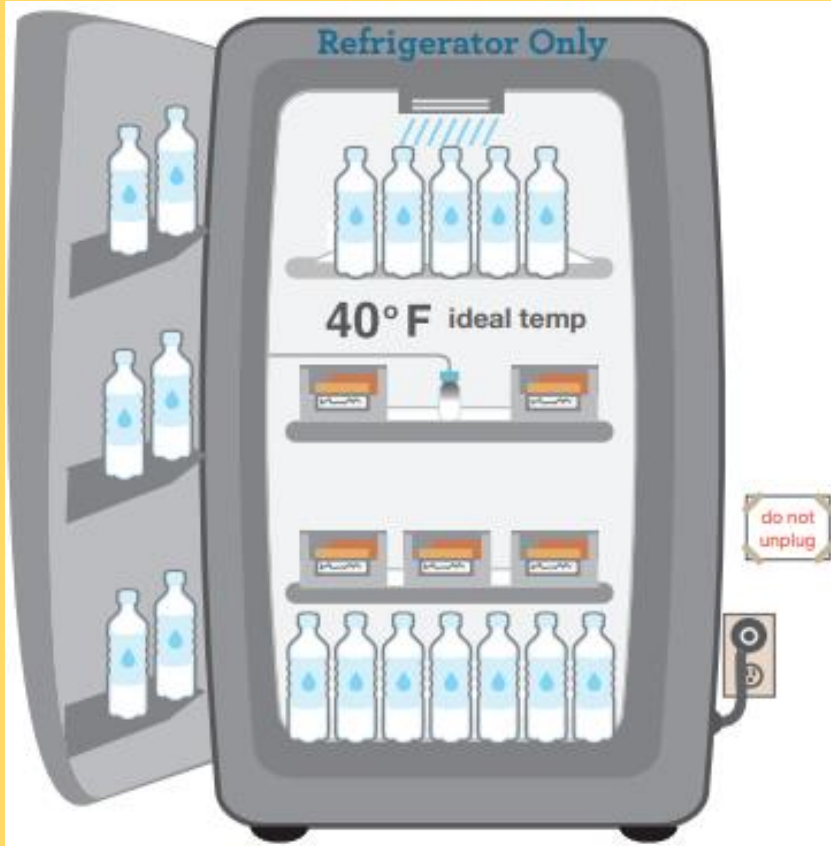
Cold Chain Flow Chart
