The CDC recommends people age 65 and older get vaccinated as soon as they can because they are at high risk of hospitalization, illness, and death from COVID-19.

All FDA-authorized COVID-19 vaccines prevent nearly 100% of hospitalizations and deaths due to COVID-19.

UNDERSTAND YOUR COVID-19: Vaccine Facts



- #1** COVID-19 vaccine will not give you COVID-19.
- #2** COVID-19 vaccines will not cause you to test positive on COVID-19 viral tests.
- #3** Getting vaccinated will help provide protection against COVID-19.
- #4** Pregnant women can get vaccinated to protect themselves and their babies.
- #5** If you have had a previous allergic reaction to injectable vaccines & medication or have previously had COVID-19, talk to your health care provider about getting your COVID-19 vaccine.

PLEASE continue to wear a mask, even after you get vaccinated, to help prevent the transmission of COVID-19

Everyone can get vaccinated. You don't need to have health insurance or be a U.S. citizen or resident.
