





**COVID-19 Updates**

- Previous recommendations from the CDC include ensuring vaccines for individuals who are eligible for additional doses of the COVID-19 vaccine
- Older adults now eligible to receive additional doses of the updated COVID-19 vaccine
  - Individuals over the age of 65 years can receive the updated 2023-2024 COVID-19 vaccine dose at least 4 months after the previous updated dose
  - Most hospitalizations and deaths from COVID-19 were among individuals who are 65 and older.

**Mobile Clinic Updates- Commercialization**

- ADHS COVID-19 Mobile clinics are coming back very soon for commercialized doses of the COVID-19 vaccine.
- The new program focuses on LTCF, nursing homes, assisted living and homebound older adults, as well as other populations not served by current vaccine allocations including Bridge, commercial pharmacies etc.
- Contracts are being finalized- more to come soon via the Vaccine Equity Task Force !

**Mobile Clinic Updates- Mpox**

- ADHS Mpox Mobile clinics are here to stay for at least another year.
- Our program uses contracted vendors to administer the JYNNEOS Mpox vaccine to those who need it at no cost.
- New campaign coming soon.

ADHS Mpox Mobile Clinic Quick Facts

- Program launched in December of 2022 as an amendment to the COVID-19 mobile vaccination program. Statewide coverage.
- This program utilizes the same mobile providers including Equality Health Foundation, DocGo by Ambulnz, to name a few.
- All vaccines are free regardless of insurance status and immigration status.
- We have done about two dozen events, mostly in collaboration with well known LGBTQIA+/HIV-services organizations such as The Southwest Center and CAN Community Health and LHD's.

Bills TAPI is Following

**HB2442 SCHOOL IMMUNIZATIONS; EXCLUSIONS**  
 Declares that an immunization for which an FDA EUA has been issued is not required for school attendance.

Transmitted to the Senate. Is still moving!

**TAPI is Opposed:** This legislation is unnecessary. Arizona law already allows parents to obtain an exemption from *any* school-required vaccine for personal belief reasons.

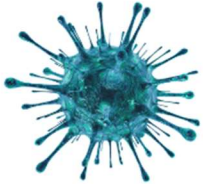
