





VFC and VFA flu doses are available to be ordered through ASIIS

As of 04/03/2024:

- 188,170 flu doses ordered
- 84,00 doses available
 - o FluMist, Fluarix, and Flucelvax syringes are no longer available to order and were restricted in the order set.
- 8.210 VFA Doses Ordered
- 1240 doses available

Memorial Day: May 27, Monday

The CDC strives to maintain an inventory with the longest possible shelf life. In general, doses will continue to ship out until the following

- Vaccine is <90 days from expiration for non-flu products
 Vaccine is <30 days from expiration for flu and COVID-19 products

We recommend placing smaller, more frequent orders to maintain your inventory.

CDC Purchase Policy Regarding Discontinued NDCs: Once the federal inventory is depleted, NDCs discontinued on CDC contracts will not be distributed by CDC, even if they are still available for purchase on the private market.

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Vaccine Changes/Updates:

- As of 03/31/2024, Nirsevimab/Beyfortus™, a long-acting monoclonal antibody immunization, is no longer being administered to align with the RSV vaccination
- If you have any Nirsevimab/Beyfortiis™ immunizations, please do not return them
- to the warehouse, but ensure you staff is no longer administering them.

 o Providers who have Nirsevimab/Beyfortus™ inventory on hand at the end of the 2023-2024 vaccination season should store the product for use in the next season of 2024-2025, based on its current shelf life.

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Updated Special Considerations for COVID-19 Vaccine and Nirsevimab

On 04/02/2024 and 04/03/2024, BIZS sent additional information and guidance on COVID-19 vaccine and nirsevimab to VFC formulary via email and Granicus


- Arizona <u>WILL NOT</u> require VFC providers to meet the private inventory minimum requirement for the COVID-19 vaccine or nirsevimab if they do not intend to vaccinate
- requirement for the COVID-19 vaccine or nirsevimab if they do not intend to vaccinate their private pay patients.

 VFC providers that plan to not maintain private stock during this season will need to:

 Explore other in-network options for their privately insured patients to access the COVID-19 vaccine and risevimab (i.e., from another local in-network practice or system, Federally Qualified Health Center, Rural Health Clinic, or deputized VFC providers that ultrorized to immunize underinsured children who do have a private inventory of COVID-19 vaccine or nissevimab).

 VFC providers that plan to immunize privately insured patients must meet the private inventory requirement by August 31, 2025.

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Communications Updates:

• The BIZS will send mass email updates (via granicus system) on pertinent VFC/VFA or COVID-19 vaccine information as well as provide regular clinical information on vaccine schedules and general vaccine reminders. 
HB2442 SCHOOL IMMUNIZATIONS; EXCLUSIONS
Declares that an immunization for which an FDA EUA has been issued is not required for school attendance.

Transmitted to the Senate.
Last action: Senate Caucus; March 19, 2024: Y

TAPI is Opposed: This legislation is unnecessary. Arizona law already allows parents to obtain an exemption from any school-required vaccine for personal belief reasons.

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

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
