

COMMUNITY EDUCATION INITATIVE

TAPI's Community Education Initiative program has been able to recruit over 100 medical professionals and translators to go out into the community to give educational presentations and answer questions regarding COVID-19.

Organizations have requested volunteers prior to vaccine events to help address hesitancy and requested volunteers that could speak specific languages and translate for members of their community.



UNIVERSITY VACCINE CAMPAIGN

TAPI created a poster titled "Public Health 101: Beating a Twindemic" with 5 questions to share and educate students about the flu and COVID-19 vaccines. Students will have the option to submit the answers to the questions to be entered to win a prize.

TAPI is hosting a TikTok video challenge for students to discuss the importance of getting flu and COVID vaccines to peers. Videos will be submitted and reviewed for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners receiving a cash prize.



VACCINE FINDER

TAPI has launched the TAPI Vaccine Finder, a new online tool to help individuals statewide find COVID-19 vaccine providers nearest to their home and to obtain free transportation to the appointment if available. From a computer, touchscreen tablet, or smart phone, volunteers can help individuals search for an address or click on a map to view nearby vaccine clinics/pop-up events, the vaccines offered, and contact information to schedule an appointment. TAPI is currently working on updates to the tool to include vaccine search options, COVID-19 testing locations, and tribal boundary views.
