

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### Coming Soon New VFC Enrollment Process


- When a provider is newly onboard with the VFC Program, the BIZS will issue a Notice of Action (NOA) indicating that the provider has met all VFC qualifications to receive a patient panel.
- AHCCCS will send the notification in the Health Plans

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### 2024-2025 Seasonal Influenza Vaccines

- As of 11/15/2024
  - 119,680 VFC flu doses ordered
  - 130,110 doses available
  - 8,750 does VFA flu doses ordered
  - 1,350 doses available




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### RSV Vaccines/Nirsevimab Befortus


- Pfizer Abrysvo and Nirsevimab/Beyfortus open for VFC ordering in ASIS
- The ordering cap for the 50mg and 100mg presentation has increased to 100 doses per order. If additional doses are needed please send an email to [Arizona.VFC@azdhs.gov](mailto:Arizona.VFC@azdhs.gov).

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2024-2025  
COVID-19 Vaccines

- Pfizer, Moderna, and Novavax COVID-19 vaccines are authorized by the FDA
- Pfizer, Moderna, and Novavax are available to order in ASIIS for VFC/VFA
  - If a presentation is not currently available, it will show as “unavailable” on the ASIIS order screen, and you will need to wait until it becomes available. There are no guarantees of when presentations will become available.




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Special Considerations

**Borrowing Exceptions:**

- One-directional borrowing of private vaccines is allowable and unique to the *seasonal influenza vaccine*.
- VFC providers who *maintain private stock of COVID-19 vaccine and nirsevimab* for privately insured children, bidirectional borrowing will be allowed for the 2024-2025 respiratory virus season. (See [Module 10 - Addendum: Special Considerations for COVID-19 Vaccine and Nirsevimab](#))

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Advertising Vaccines for Transfer: Available in VOMS

- On October 3, 2024 a RedCap email was sent to providers regarding the new feature in ASIIS.
- This feature enables other VFC-enrolled providers in good standing (with no open incidents) to advertise soon-to-expire vaccines(at least 90 days before the expiration date), view other available transfers, and submit transfer requests.
- Authorized users will have access to a comprehensive list of all available vaccines across the state—please be mindful to select providers within reasonable proximity (Transport should not take longer than 30 minutes), avoiding selections from organizations/facilities located too far away.


**Reminder:** All vaccine transports must adhere to established vaccine transport protocols to ensure vaccine integrity and must be approved by the BIZS before transport occurs.



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VFC Annual Coordinator Training


- The BIZS is updating the AIPOTrain Learning Management System. During this time, the Annual VFC Coordinator training course will not be available.
  - If your annual training has expired or you need to renew your training in the meantime, please complete the CDC's "You Call the Shots" training. You can choose either the Vaccines for Children module or the Vaccine Storage and Handling module.



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Immunization Advisory Committee (ADHS IAC)


- On October 31, 2024, a transitional meeting was conducted with the VFC Workgroup. To continue to enhance communication, collaboration, ongoing engagement, and feedback with key stakeholders, the ADHS Bureau of Immunization Services (BIZS) is establishing an Immunization Advisory Committee (ADHS IAC) of 15-20 members. Meetings will be held quarterly and will encompass:
  - Government and Public Health representatives (rural and urban)
  - Healthcare Providers and Systems
  - Professional Associations
  - Community and Non-Profit Organizations
  - Educational Institutions
  - Tribal and Indigenous Community Leaders
  - Health Plans
  - Parents, Caregivers, and Family Advocates
  - Youth Service Organizations and Advocacy Groups
  - Experts in Data, Technology, and Reporting (STC)

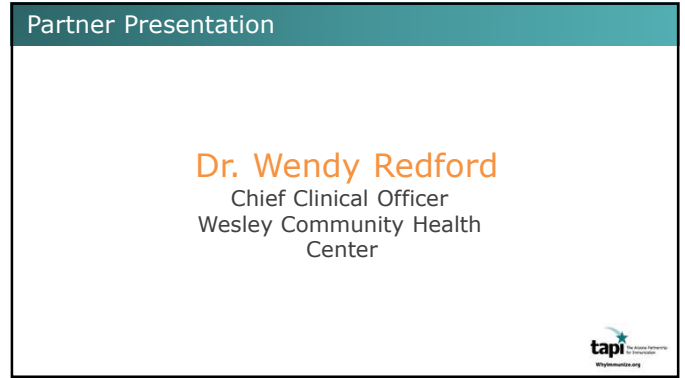
- The [2024-2025 Holiday Vaccine Shipping Schedule](#) was shared this past week on 11/07/2024.

  - Tuesday, 12/24/2024 through Thursday, 12/26/2024 (Christmas)
  - Wednesday, 01/01/2025 through Thursday, 01/02/2025 (New Year's)



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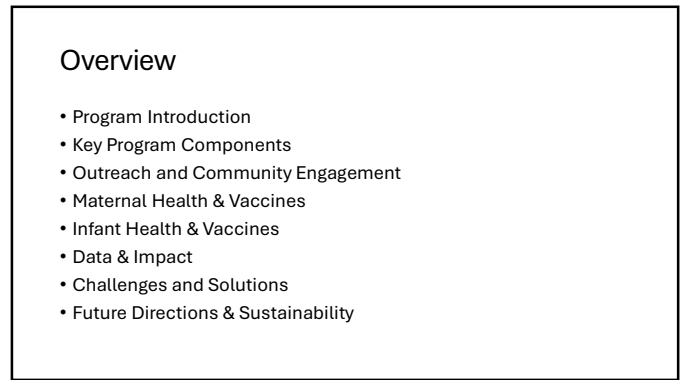
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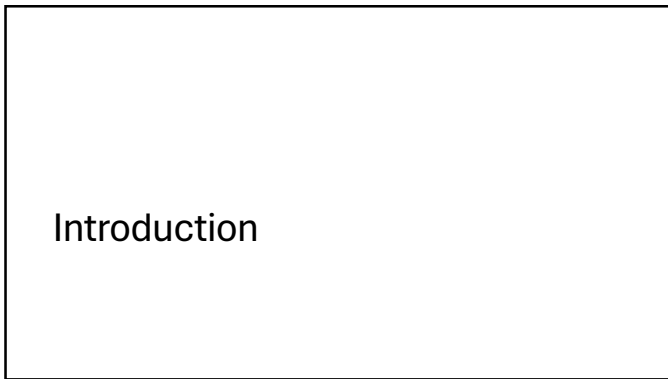
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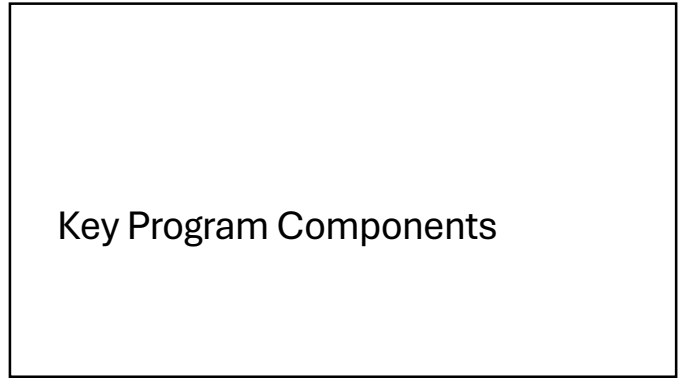

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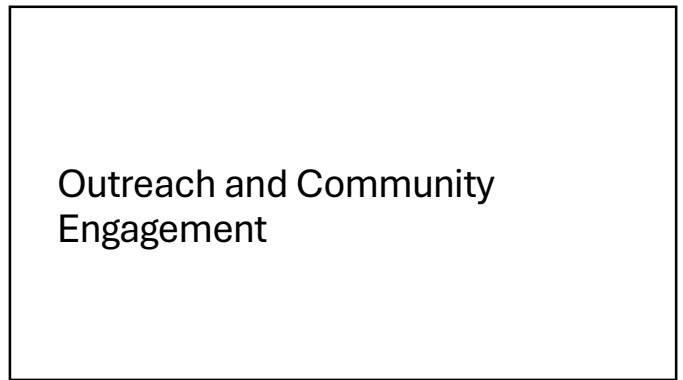
## Key Program Components

### Key Mobile Health Program Components

- **Mobile Health Units:**
  - Wesley has been operating mobile health units since 2021, with the Mom and Baby Mobile beginning service delivery in Spring 2024.
  - Service delivery locations are driven by community interest and need, and partnering with organizations that have common goals in serving the underserved. We often seek out agencies that have strengths in complementary areas with unmet healthcare needs. Greatest successes are partnerships with organizations that have staff dedicated to facilitating this access to care and supporting coordination.
- **Healthcare Services Provided:**
  - Preconception, prenatal, and postpartum care
  - Well and sick child visits
  - Comprehensive primary care for the entire family
  - Vaccination services for mothers and infants.
  - Health education on nutrition, breastfeeding, and infant care.



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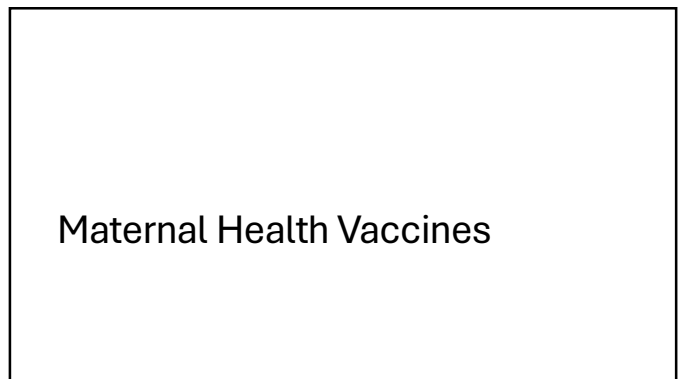
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## Outreach and Community Engagement

### Outreach and Community Engagement

- **Target Areas & Communities:**
  - There are a multitude of factors contributing to lack of access to care. Two million women live in counties where there's a lack of maternity care resources, no hospitals or birth centers offering obstetric care, and no obstetric providers. There's a long concern that there's mistrust in the institution of healthcare, which may be emphasized within marginalized communities due to discrimination concerns. Institutional or structural factors in the social environment can shape a person's health, propensity to illness, and access to care.
  - Focus is on reaching patients who would otherwise forgo care for any of these reasons.
- **Community Outreach Strategies:**
  - Example: Hushabye Nursery
  - Coordination with community leaders to identify needs and promote connection to care
  - Culturally sensitive and language-appropriate outreach methods.
  - Mobile app/website for appointment scheduling and follow-ups.

  - Vaccines recommended for pregnant women (e.g., Tdap, flu vaccine, COVID, RSV).
  - Benefits for maternal and infant health.

  - How vaccines are administered on-site.
  - Ensuring vaccine access to pregnant women who may not have access to traditional healthcare settings.
  - Partnership with local health departments or organizations for vaccine distribution.

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

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## Data and Impact

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## Data and Impact

- Total number of visits in 2023: **4,393**
- Prenatal visits: **2,542**
  - Postpartum visits: **346**
  - Other reproductive health visits: **120**
  - Well-woman visits: **328**
  - Well-child visits: **135**
  - Other visits (adult primary care, family medicine, social worker visit, etc.): **926**
- Total number of patients served: **1,140**
- 68%** of all visits served uninsured patients
- In 2023, mobile health centers provided care for patients on **more than half the days of the year (51% of days)**
- Total number of locations where services were provided: **23**
- From 2021 to 2023 there was a **33% increase** in the number of visits and a **48% increase** in the number of patients served.


- The Phoenix metropolitan area encompasses Maricopa and Pinal Counties and the city of Phoenix – Arizona's largest city and the fifth largest city in the nation. While Arizona has experienced significant population growth over the last decade, social drivers of health such as housing, transportation, nutrition, healthcare costs, and poverty levels have exponentially increased. The new Mobile Health program in Phoenix bridges these critical gaps to accessing high-quality healthcare in underserved communities in the region.
- The mobile health unit also serves as a place of care and provide valuable clinical experiences for undergraduate nursing students, nurse practitioner students, and other allied health students. The students apply their knowledge to seeing patients in the mobile health unit under the direction of the dual-appointed ASU Edison College nurse practitioner faculty member.

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## Challenges and Solutions

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### Challenges and Solutions

- Challenges in Reaching Underserved Populations:
  - Barriers such as transportation, lack of awareness, and cultural factors.
  - Addressing vaccine hesitancy.
- Program Solutions:
  - Mobile units overcoming transportation barriers.
  - Community-based education and engagement efforts.
  - Tailored communication strategies to address concerns about vaccines.

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## Future Directions and Sustainability

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### Future Directions & Sustainability

- Expansion Plans:
  - Scaling the program to reach more communities.
  - Integrating additional health services (e.g., mental health support for new mothers, chronic disease management).
- Sustainability Efforts:
  - Partnerships with government agencies, nonprofits, and private sectors.
  - Long-term funding strategies and community involvement.

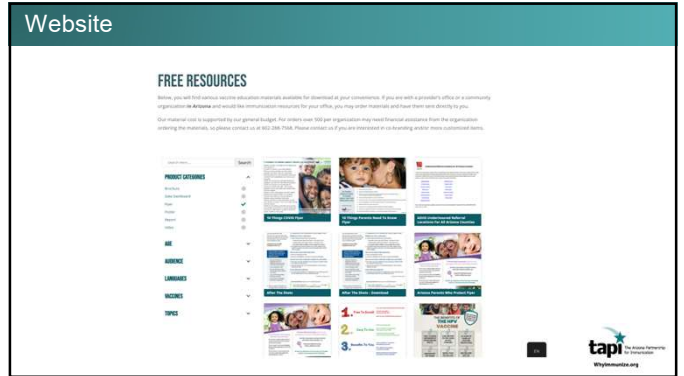

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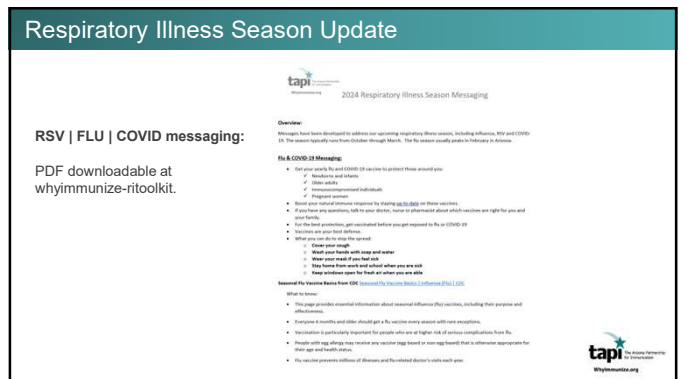

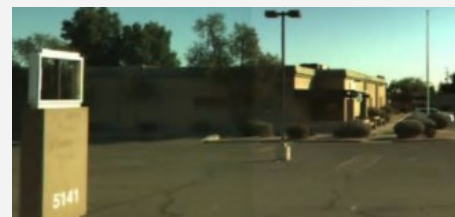
