- Total VFC Flu Doses Ordered - 191,860
- Total VFA Flu Doses Ordered - 8,330

- All VFC/VFA flu doses are **Expired**
- On 06/17/2024, a [VFC influenza vaccines will expire on 06/30/2024](#). Granicus was sent to all VFC/VFA enrolled providers with detailed instructions on accounting for the expired vaccines. An additional notice was sent on 07/01/2024 via RedCap.

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## VFC Annual Re-Enrollment 2024



- Re-enrollment started on **May 3, 2024** and ends on **August 31, 2024**. An email was sent to all enrolled providers with the announcement.
- Providers will be required to re-enroll for the 2024 VFC year by completing the Provider Agreement and uploading ALL required re-enrollment documents to <https://redcap.link/reenrollment2024>

Please note: There has been a change in facility-type reporting. Community Health Center is no longer an option. If your facility was identified as a Community Health Center in previous years, please select Community Vaccinator as your facility type if it is still applicable.

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## Vaccine Changes/Updates:

**NEW NDCs: (Available for ordering in August)**

Bavarian Nordic:

- Jynneos; MPOX; IPV; SDV; 10-pack; NDC: 50632-0001-03
  - Eligibility 18+ and must meet VFC eligibility requirements
  - A Granicus will be sent to VFC providers with additional information.

Sanofi Pasteur- MenQuadfi® will be supplied in packages of 10 vials instead of 5 vials. We anticipate the transition will occur in August 2024.

- MenQuadfi® NDC replacement is 49281-0590-10

**CDC Purchase Policy Regarding Discontinued NDCs:** Once the federal inventory is depleted, NDCs discontinued on CDC contracts will not be distributed by CDC, even if they are still available for purchase on the private market.

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

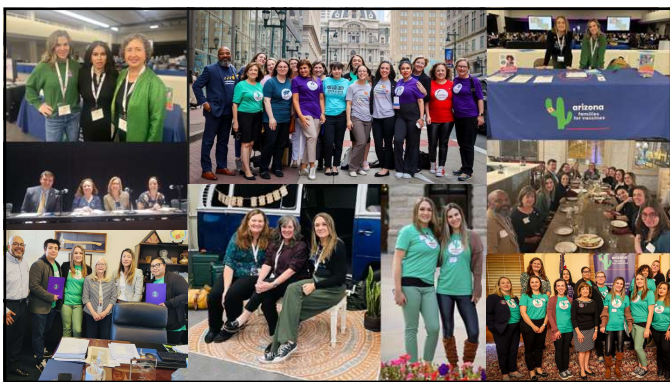

Arizona 24-36 month olds protected against measles as of February 2023

How the cost of the year, there have been no outbreaks of measles in our state, and measles has virtually disappeared. This success is because of local providers, working in close collaboration with parents, and because of our state's robust surveillance system. Measles is a highly contagious, and deadly virus that causes ear infections, pneumonia, meningitis, and death. One in four people with measles are hospitalized, and one-third can lose their eyes and hearing.

It is an extraordinary feat that our state has achieved. Measles has been eliminated due to the high vaccination rates. Measles, still circulating, which may be between 1-2% of measles of age 1-5.

Normally, only 99.9% of measles' recipients will have their first and second vaccine.

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## Vaccine Trends

### Parental Rights


- Preventing or administratively burdening foster parents and group homes from vaccinating.
- Preventing teenagers from electing to vaccinate.
- Allowing parents to opt out of data collection, impacting registries.



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## Vaccine Trends



### Schools and Childcare

- Increasing exemptions for schools and childcare.
- Removing any requirement to show vaccination records to schools.
- Removing/prohibiting certain vaccine requirements for school attendance.
- Notifying parents of exemption information.



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## Vaccine Trends

### Limitations on Vaccinated Blood

- Blood donor must report their vaccination status.
- Blood donation recipients can request non-vaccinated blood.
- Requiring certain tests (sometimes that don't exist) for donated blood.


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## Vaccine Trends

### mRNA Vaccines

- Meat from animals that have not received an mRNA vaccine can be labeled "mRNA free."
- Any food that has received a vaccine must be labeled as a drug, aka "lettuce bills."
- Preventing State Veterinarian from administering mRNA vaccines in an emergency situation.
- Banning mRNA products, with criminal penalties.



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## Vaccine Trends

# WORK

### Discrimination

- Preventing employers from "discriminating" against employees based on vaccination status.
- Preventing employers from requiring employees to receive vaccines. Any individual harmed by an employer-required vaccine may sue the employer.
- Individuals and/or businesses may not refuse to provide services based on an individual's vaccination status.
- Discrimination in a school setting


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## Vaccine Trends

### World Health Organization

- Preventing states from utilizing WHO (and sometimes CDC) recommendations to justify state policy
- Opposing WHO pandemic agreement.



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### Ways to be a Pro-Vaccine Advocate

- Work with the Medical Staff in your office about developing office-wide policies and strategies to address and overcome misinformation your patients may believe.
- Speak up on social media, in your family, and in social settings, correcting vaccine misinformation.
- Learn how to use the Request to Speak system so you can urge your elected officials to support or oppose bills in the Arizona legislature before they become law. This is done from your phone or your couch and doesn't involve traveling to the Capitol! We can help sign you up and train you.
- Teach other like-minded people how to use the Request to Speak system so they can weigh in on bills too.
- Sign up to receive our emails so we can inform you about vaccine legislation moving through the Legislature, and you can write/call your legislators with your position on vaccine legislation.
- Attend our annual Day of Advocacy and show everyone at the Arizona Capitol that the majority of Arizonans support vaccines.
- Come testify at the Arizona legislature, or be an expert resource for us regarding our testimony.

### Please Bring All Immunization Records

**To be eligible for these free immunizations the child must:** be covered by AHCCCS, be uninsured, have insurance that does not cover immunizations, be Native American or an Alaskan Native.

Children with private insurance that covers 100 percent of immunizations must visit their private health care provider.
