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History

Reported Measles Cases in the United States from 1962 - 2023*



- 1757- Francis Home, a Scottish physician, demonstrated that measles is caused by an infectious agent in the blood of patients.
- 1912- Measles became a nationally **notifiable disease** in the United States (average of 6,000 measles-related deaths per year).
- 1963- A **vaccine became available**. John Enders and colleagues transformed the Edmonston-B strain of measles virus into a vaccine and licensed it in the United States.
- 1968- an improved and even weaker measles vaccine was developed (only measles vaccine used in the United States since 1968)
- 1978- CDC set a goal to eliminate measles from the United States by 1982.
- **Measles was declared eliminated from the United States in 2000**. This meant the absence of the continuous spread of disease was greater than 12 months.

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Measles outbreak

- As of 2/27/2025, a total of 164 measles cases were reported: Alaska, California, Georgia, Kentucky, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York City, Rhode Island, and Texas.
- There have been 3 outbreaks (defined as 3 or more related cases) reported in 2025, and **93% of cases (153 of 164) are outbreak-associated**.
 - 16 outbreaks were reported during 2024 and 69% of cases (198 of 285) were outbreak-associated.

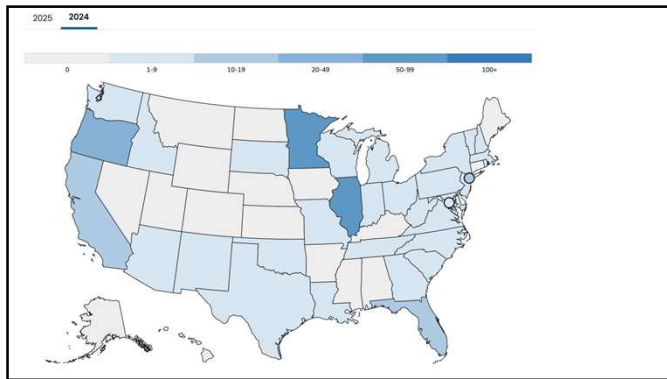

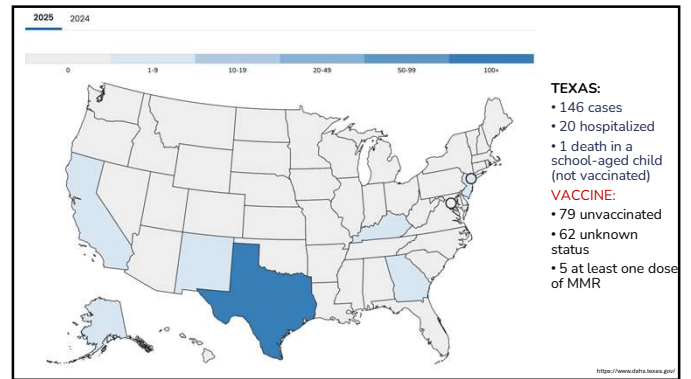

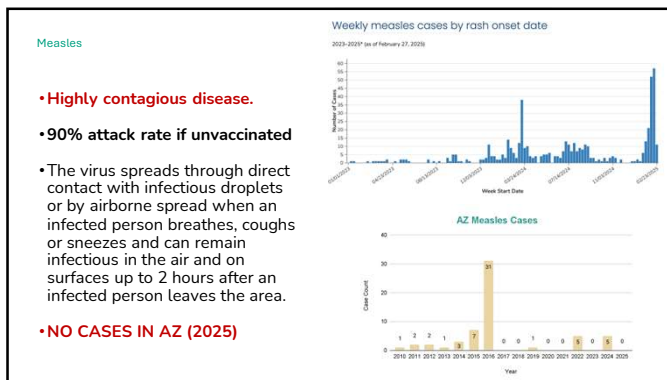
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Measles clinical presentation

- Measles typically begins with fever, cough, runny nose, and pink eye that lasts 2-4 days before a rash begins.
- A person with measles is contagious from 4 days before the start of the rash through 4 days after the rash begins.
- Measles can cause severe health complications including pneumonia, encephalitis, and death.

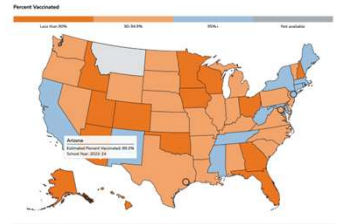
"COUGH, CORYZA, CONJUNCTIVITIS"



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Vaccine

- Vaccination is the best way to prevent measles.
- **Two doses of the MMR vaccine provide 97% protection against measles.**
- Children are recommended to receive the **first dose at 12-15 months**, and the **second at 4-6 years**
- Anyone exposed to a case of measles should monitor for symptoms for 3 weeks from last exposure and call their healthcare provider if symptoms develop.
- **Contacts who are unvaccinated should:**
 - Receive a **dose of MMR vaccine** (within 72 hours of exposure) OR
 - Receive **measles immunoglobulin** (if unable to receive MMR vaccine) within 6 days of exposure



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Most important

- Educate staff about measles (symptoms, what to do)
- Early identification → Isolation, early testing, decreases unnecessary exposures
- Contact infection prevention → local health department
- Rash+ Fever + risk factors (unvaccinated)= ISOLATE
- Vaccination

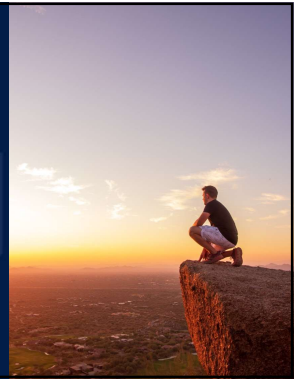

CARES Team

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Immunization Outreach Team (formerly known as immunization equity)

Activity Description

Engage and work with partners to identified communities without access to immunizations and work with the Strike Team to provide the Immunizations.



Expanding our outreach to do immunizations: first two months of 2025 we set up clinics with Buddhist Temples in remote areas.

- ❖ We added an outreach coordinator to work with Refugee-underserved populations and in the first two months we set up education and clinics with Thai and Burmese communities. Although there is some hesitancy, people trusted the messenger that hosted the clinic and got vaccinated in a space that is safe and known to them.
- ❖ We learned that partners are willing to bring education and host clinics however, there is hesitancy among the refugee populations to get vaccinated. Many think that after getting the first COVID vaccine they are all covered and don't need another one. Also, many are hesitant about the flu vaccine but if the host says its ok to get it, people are willing to get it.
- ❖ Partner with trusted voices that can help bring the message that vaccines are safe. We have partner with two more sites to bring COVID and flu vaccines. Also, have an interactive fun way to learn about vaccines. We use booklets in multiple languages.

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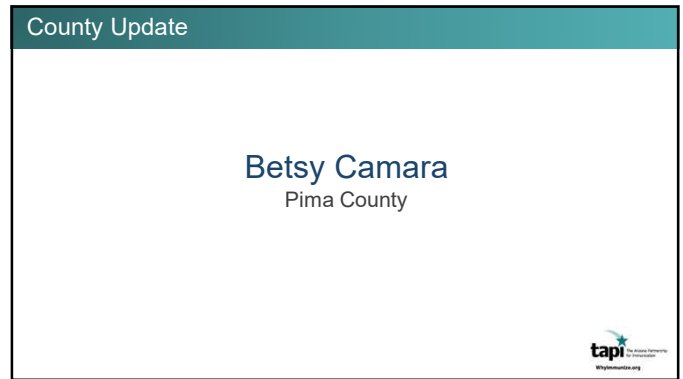
