





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As of July 01, 2025, Phoenix has been officially designated as a jurisdiction for the Vaccines for Children (VFC) Program under the Maricopa County Department of Public Health (MCDPH).
 Communication will be shared with all providers via RedCap Email.

The Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) Bureau of Immunization Services (BIZS) will continue to provide support to VFC providers across Arizona, working closely with Maricopa County for providers in Phoenix.

Please continue to follow the guidelines in the Arizona Vaccines for Children (VFC) Operations Guide while we navigate this transition.

A joint webinar with ADHS and MCDPH will be scheduled soon to help everyone prepare for the changes ahead, before any modifications are implemented.
