Measles Overview

Arizona Measles Outbreak Incident Summary

- The Mohave Measles Outbreak has **officially concluded**, with response operations wrapping up in June 2026.
- Prioritization of orders for MMR and MMRV vaccines was **discontinued** as of June 9, 2026.
- The outbreak resulted in **325 confirmed cases**.
- The ADHS will **continue to monitor** for new incidents or cases and provide communication and guidance as needed.

2026-2027 Pediatric RSV Planning

What Arizona VFC Providers Need to Know

- RSV ordering will open once the CDC provides an official date of release.
- The CDC has not confirmed if there will be allocations for the upcoming season.
- CDC awarded adult and pediatric COVID-19 vaccine contracts for Moderna, Pfizer, and Sanofi effective **June 1, 2026, through May 31, 2027**. Initially only the 2025-2026 Moderna and Pfizer NDCs will be available for ordering. Once the 2026-2027 COVID-19 products are approved by the U. S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA), all Moderna, Pfizer, and Sanofi NDCs will be available to order.

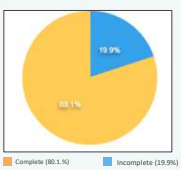

Approved vs. Incomplete Submissions



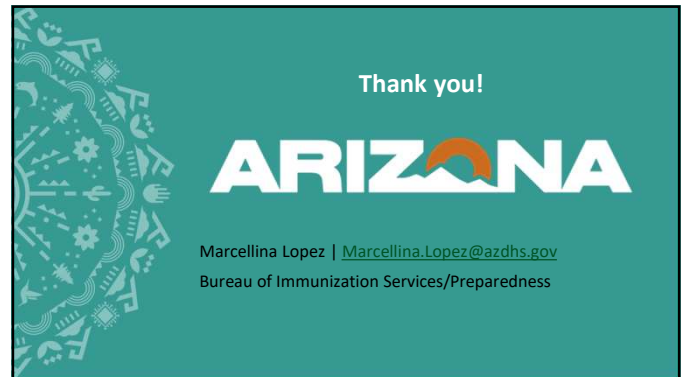

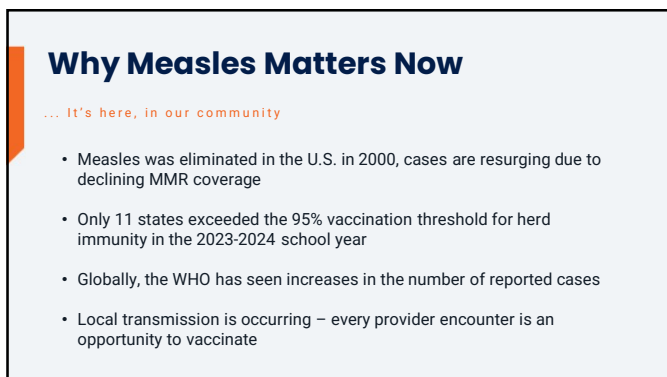
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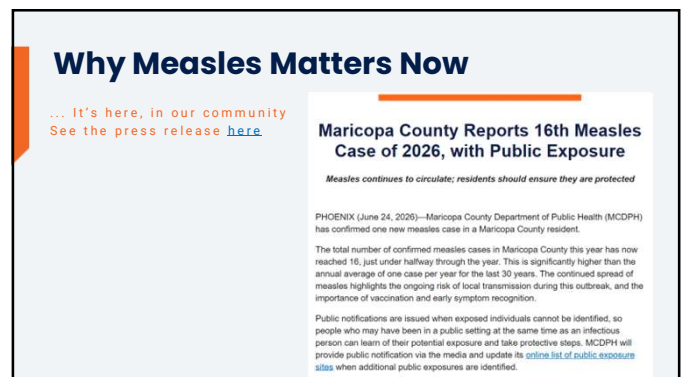

Online Patient Scheduling

BOOK AN APPOINTMENT ONLINE

Use our online booking system through Medline to request an appointment for consultations, virtually administered children (VIA) testing, or laboratory (LAB) testing services.

Please read the following information before making your request:

What to know before you book

- Choose the service and location that best matches what you need.
 - Full name
 - Date of birth
 - Contact information (the phone number and email address)
- Book only one appointment for the same visit. Choose the location and time that work best for you. Do not create multiple appointments.
- For same-day appointments, choose a time at least three hours from when you submit your request.
- To cancel or reschedule, call the clinic.

When you arrive for your appointment

You must arrive 15 minutes early for check-in and appointment.

- Bring necessary documents to your appointment:
 - Insurance ID
 - Insurance card (if using insurance)
 - Any relevant medical records

Important: Online appointment requests are not automatically booked

- Your selected time slot will allow us to review your request. You will receive a confirmation notice once your appointment is approved.
- Requests submitted after hours or on weekends will be reviewed the next business day.

After you request an appointment

- Check your email for a confirmation notice.
- If you do not receive confirmation within one business day, call the clinic.

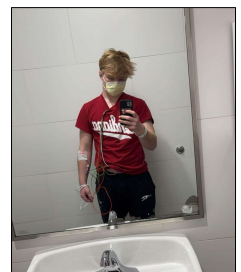

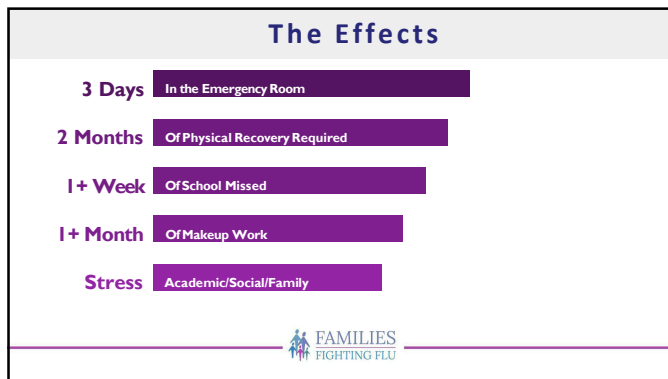
